### **Vampire Facials at The Naderi Center**

[Micro-needling](#) and PRP treatments can treat a wide range of skin concerns. Patients with uneven pigmentation, scars, fine lines, wrinkles, stretch marks, or uneven skin texture can enjoy brighter skin with a more youthful and even complexion after a Vampire Facial.

The Vampire Facial at The Naderi Center combines two different treatments to optimize patients’ results. It begins with a micro-needling procedure. Dr. Kulak uses the Collagen P.I.N micro-needling device, which is a roller equipped with tiny needles to create channels of controlled injuries to the facial skin. These tiny pinpricks prompt the body’s natural healing responses, encouraging the development of new collagen to repair the skin.

Once the channels have been made, Dr. Kulak fills them with platelet-rich plasma, or PRP. PRP contains growth factors that help to enhance the skin rejuvenation results. The plasma comes from the patient’s blood, which is drawn during the appointment and processed to separate the PRP. This not only helps encourage skin rejuvenation, but it also ensures that there are no adverse reactions, since the patient’s own plasma is used. Most patients require 3-6 treatments, spaced approximately 4 weeks apart, for best results. Patients also use special skincare products following each treatment to further improve skin rejuvenation.
